2. English Proficiency

1. A completed application form
2. Official transcript of the previous university attended (2 copies)
3. Bachelor's Degree Certificate (2 copies)
4. Citizen identification card and residence registration
- for Thai applicants (2 copies)
5. Passport - for non-Thai applicants (3 copies)
6. Three (1 X 1.5-inch size) Photographs (photo in gown not essential)
7. Resume (2 copies)

Note : All documents must be endorsed with signature and submitted in person within the last day of application period, otherwise the application will not be considered and the applicant will not be allowed to sit for the Admission interview.
