QUALIFICATIONS FOR ADMISSION

- 1. Eligibility for a student visa to study in Germany.
- First bachelor degree must be in Business Administration or Management only and minimum CGPA of Bachelor's Degree is 2.00 on 4.00 scale.
- Student must obtain the CGPA for AU-MBA or AU-MS.MGT of at least 3.50 to study at University of Applied Sciences Mainz (Mainz), Germany.
- 4. Adequate undergraduate training to do graduate work in the M.B.A. Program.
- 5. Good command of English.
- 6. Computer literacy.
- 7. Basic German knowledge of A2 level. (Students can also take a course German A1.1 in Bangkok and continue German during their academic year in Mainz. They must prove German A2 level before graduation).
- 8. Student must have the IELTS Scores of 6.5 (or TOEFL iBT: 92/TOEFL CBT 237 or TOEIC score of at least 800 points)
- 9. Another language on B2 level (e.g. Thai as native language).

- 8. 2 Copies of Basic German knowledge of A2 level
- 9. 2 Copies of Another language on B2 level
- 10. 2 Copies of Name Change Certificate If any

EXEMPTION

The English entrance examination can be exempted depending on which of the following conditions you satisfy.

- A TOEFL score of (iBT) 90 or (PBT) 575 or an IELTS (Academic) score of at least 6.5 (Validation: Two years).
- A Bachelor's degree or a higher degree from native English speaking countries (e.g. USA, Canada, UK, Australia and New Zealand).

Note: All documents must be endorsed with signature and submitted in person within the last day application period, otherwise the application will not be considered and the applicant will not be allowed to sit for the Admission interview.
